TREC SOUTH WEST RULES

Please retain for future reference.

1. DEFRA may require competitors to produce their passport at any time;
2. Insurance companies and equine organisations recommend that hard hats conform to a minimum BSI standard of EN1384 or PAS015. Hats meeting these standards must be worn and correctly fastened whilst mounted.
3. Riders must wear suitable riding footwear.
4. Riders must wear "Hi-Viz" or fluorescent clothing during the POR section of competitions and during POR training.
5. All competitors/riders must have 3rd party insurance/public liability and submit documentary evidence of such if required (eg BHS Gold membership)
6. Riders under the age of 16 can join as part of a family and must be accompanied by a rider aged over 16 for POR and POR training rides.
7. All vehicles are parked at owners' risk.
8. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Some venues may not allow dogs; you will be notified in advance.
9. Horses/ponies must be at least 4 years old.
10. Please take care to safeguard tack and possessions.
11. Young children must be supervised at all times.
12. TREC SOUTH WEST has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone at all events. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of officials and stewards.
